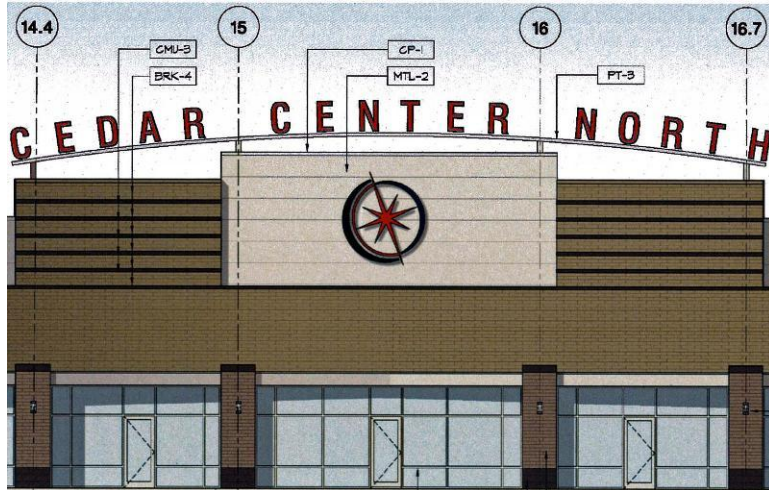

The Coral Company and DeVille Developments presented their plans to South Euclid City Council and members of the public at Council's September 12 Meeting. The proposal includes over 60,000 square feet of new restaurants and retail, which they plan to have under construction this year.



The new development will include approximately 15-20 new restaurants and shops for our residents and will be developed by the Coral Company and DeVille Developments. The new shopping district, which will open in 2012, will also feature several areas for outdoor dining and a large greenspace area (about the size of the greenspace at Legacy Village!) that residents will be able to use for picnics, band concerts, arts and craft festivals, movie nights and other community events.

Coral Company & DeVille Developments have received approval from the Architectural Review Board and tentative approval from the Planning Commission. Pending City Council and final approvals from the Planning Commission, construction is slated to begin within 30-60 days.

The Green Neighborhoods Initiative is funded through grants and federal stimulus dollars. The initiative takes foreclosed and vacant bank-owned homes and rehabilitates them utilizing green-building methods and universal design features. The innovative green-building concept was created by the City in collaboration with City Architecture, Zaremba Home Again Restoration Company and students from the Cleveland Institute of Art. In addition, three Community Gardens successfully completed their second season and were sponsored by the City and supported by Whole Foods Markets, volunteers and in-kind donations.

Three of the four Green Homes have been sold, with more restorations of vacant homes on the way. In addition, a new Green Home will be built on Linnell Road.

"The Green Neighborhoods Initiative is an innovative counter-attack to the foreclosure crisis that will be replicable by government and the private sector in every neighborhood across the country," said South Euclid Mayor Georgine Welo. "This unique utilization of federal stimulus funds will showcase how we can transform abandoned homes into attractive, first-choice housing options for modern buyers of all ages."
