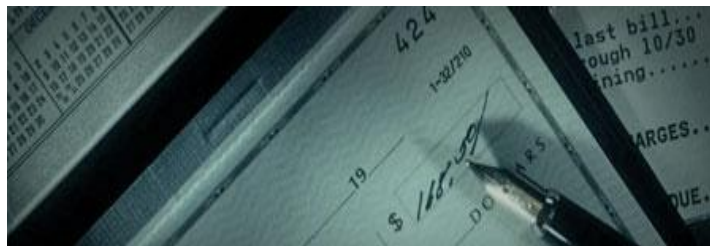

Government's rating), Moody's, one of the Country's leading credit agencies, has **reaffirmed the city's financial health and fiscal plan by maintaining the city's Aa2 rating, the second highest financial credit rating for government entities.** Moody's credit affirmation is an outstanding achievement for an inner-ring suburb like South Euclid.

At the September 26 City Council Meeting, Jeff Rink, director of Key Bank's Capital Markets and the city's financial adviser, reported to City Council that Moody's reported that the credit rating is attributed to strong financial management by the City and City Council and the administration's ability to adjust the budget mid-year and utilize conservative budgeting.

South Euclid, like nearly all communities in northeast Ohio and across the nation, has seen costs to provide city services increase, while revenues continue to drop or remain flat as a result of downturn in our nation's economy and the foreclosure crisis in the housing market.

"As we move through these tough economic times, South Euclid is holding its own," said Rink.

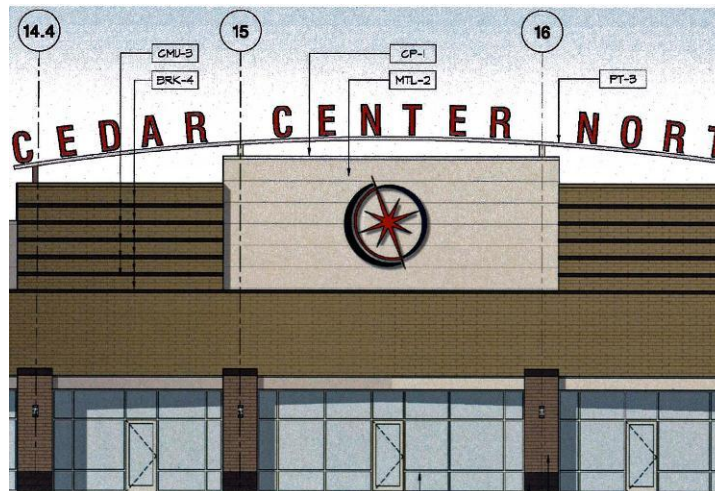
the announcement that Bob Evans will build one of their first inner-ring suburban restaurants in South Euclid at Cedar Center North!

On October 10 City Council approved the sale of 0.7 acres of property to Bob Evans. Construction will begin in the next few weeks, with expected opening in Spring 2012.

The City's agreement with Bob Evans complements additional plans for phase one of the Cedar Center Redevelopment Project, proposed by Coral Company and DeVille Developments, which will include additional retail stores and restaurants.

## **Fall Leaf Collection Tips.**



### **How do I know when you will be picking up on my street?**

To improve communication with residents as to when leaf pickup will occur on your street, the City has instituted a phone hotline to provide you with information.

**Please call the Service Department at [216.381.0402](tel:216.381.0402) after 4 pm Monday through Friday to see where the crews will be picking up leaves the following day.**

### **Please utilize the guidelines below to ensure that your leaves are picked up in a timely manner:**

- Rake your leaves onto your tree lawn in a timely manner. This will help to ensure that you do not miss the crew when they are on your street.
- Take branches, twigs, rocks and other debris out of the leaf pile. Items other than leaves will damage the equipment and cause delays.
- Do not place the leaves in the roadway. Leaves can cause street flooding and also are a hazard to motorists.
- The final leaf collection, weather permitting, will be the 2nd week of December. Please have your leaves on your tree lawn before the 2nd week in December.
- If your leaves are not raked onto the tree lawn when the truck comes down your street, the Service Department will not be able to make a return trip until they

- complete their next cycle of streets.
- Remember: There is no leaf collection in the Spring.

- Cross streets only at crosswalks.
- Do not wear costumes that obscure your vision.
- Do not enter a stranger's home.
- Be prepared for adverse weather.
