SE limits number of garage sales to 4

SOUTH EUCLID — City Council voted Dec. 14 to change its laws regarding garage sales.

The change allows four garage sales per year, per household. Permits must be attained for each sale at City Hall, 1349 S. Green Road. The permits for the first three garage sales are free. The fourth permit will cost a resident \$5.

Council's Legislative Committee met in November to discuss possible changes. The committee believed changes were necessary because some

homeowners were holding many garage and yard sales per year. In some cases, according to Ward 4 Councilwoman Jane Goodman, it appeared certain homeowners were having a continuous sale throughout the summer.

The committee originally considered allowing six garage sales per year, but later, at the urging of Councilwoman at-large Sunny Simon, scaled back the number.
