



*New requirement effective January 1, 2013*

## 2013 Residential Code of Ohio

Please be advised that if you obtain a permit from the City of South Euclid for work within an existing dwelling structure, you must comply with the requirements of the code for installing a carbon monoxide detector in the home.

**RCO Section 315.2** - Where work requiring a permit occurs in existing dwellings that have attached garages or in existing dwellings within which fuel-fired appliances exist, carbon monoxide alarms shall be provided in accordance with Section 315.1.

**RCO Section 315.1** – Carbon monoxide detector shall be installed outside of each separate sleeping area in the immediate vicinity of the bedrooms.

**RCO Section 315.3** – Single station carbon monoxide alarms shall be listed as complying with UL 2034 and shall be installed with this code and the manufacturer's installation instruction.

I have read the above information and will install a carbon monoxide detector or inform the property/home owner of the code requirement to install such detector. Step One

Is the permit for work inside the house?

Yes – go to Step 2

Step Two

Does the house have an attached garage?

Yes – must install a carbon monoxide detector, go to Step 4

No – Go to Step 3

Step Three

Does the house have any fuel-fired (gas) appliances?

Yes – must install a carbon monoxide detector, go to Step 4

No – this requirement does not apply

Step Four

The individual getting a permit must sign the form and attach the original to the permit. Give a copy to the applicant.
