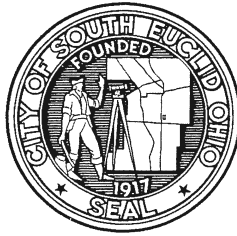

- The Lyceum School recently was granted a conditional use permit for a coeducational, college preparatory school, which is dedicated to providing a classical Catholic education to students in grades 7-12.
