What do you know about the “South Euclid Open Space Plan”?

South Euclid is embarking on a new objective to look at the balance of open space in the city and develop a plan that would best utilize the space. Consultants from Cleveland State University have been hired, with grant money, to help the city develop the plan. The preliminary project plan lists 6 phases that will last approximately 12 months. The phases are as follows:

1. Phase one: Start up
2. Phase two: Inventory of open space
3. Phase three: Goals and Objectives for open space
4. Phase four: Concept Plans to utilize the open space
5. Phase 5: Preferred Plans for the open space
6. Phase 6: Final Plan for the open space

Would you be interested in serving on the Open Space Committee? The Open Space Committee’s responsibility is to serve as an advisor to the City and the Consultant team throughout the planning process. The committee would be responsible for recommending the plan to the Planning Commission and City Council. You would be required to attend five (5) meetings over the next 12 months.
