CITY COUNCIL TOWN-HALL MEETINGS

In the last year, the City has lost over \$1 million a year as a result of State of Ohio cuts to the Local Government Fund, the elimination of Estate Tax and Commercial Activity Tax, along with a 12% reduction in Real Property Tax revenues. The economic recession, and the housing and foreclosure crisis have brought dramatic challenges across the country, to our region and in our community. Although we have been fiscally responsible and resilient in our response to these challenges, we find that we are facing new challenges as we confront an unprecedented series of funding cuts from the State of Ohio.

South Euclid City Council will be holding Town Hall Ward Meetings to gain your input and ideas to help us reach consensus on proposed short and long-term options aimed at reducing spending while maintaining the high level of City services we have become accustomed to in South Euclid.

Before City Council makes any decisions, we need to hear from our residents to help guide us in our decision-making process. Meetings have been scheduled for the following dates and times:

- **Council At Large Meeting (With Councilmen Miller, Fiorelli & Gelfand):** Thursday, May 2 from 6:30-8:30 pm at the South Euclid Community Center, 1370 Victory Drive.
