VOLLEYBALL NET RENTAL PROCEDURES FOR BLOCK PARTIES:

The City of South Euclid Community Center is pleased to offer a new perk for those neighborhoods holding block parties this summer. The procedures below explain how you can obtain a volleyball and net for your block party.

The Community Center has two volleyball sets—(i.e. a net and ball per set), the nets are long enough to go across the street and be tied to a utility pole or tree. The policy/process for signing out the equipment is as follows:

After filling out the Block Party Application Form and having it approved by the Mayor's Office, a representative from the neighborhood having the block party may call or email the Community Center at 216-291-0771, or mmartines@seuclid.com or kcox@seuclid.com, to request the volleyball equipment. It will be reserved on a first come, first served basis. Community Center Staff will confirm that a volleyball set will be available for your block party.

The volleyball set is available the Friday before the block party. It must be picked up in person, at the Community Center, between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. A \$25 cash only deposit is required to be made at the time of pickup, the equipment is signed out, and a copy of a state issued photo ID is made.

The net and ball must be returned the following Monday, to the Community Center, between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. The equipment is signed in and the \$25 cash deposit is returned to the individual. If the equipment is not returned to the Community Center by 5:00 p.m. that Monday, the deposit is not returned, regardless of if/when the equipment does come back.

The Community Center is also seeking donations of complete sets for croquet, bocce, horseshoes, corn hole, or badminton. We would then make them available as well for block parties.
