

Waste Material Information

Rubbish cannot be placed on tree lawn before 6 pm the evening before pickup and empty containers must be removed from tree lawn within 12 hours after pickup.

- A. Bulky articles such as large boxes, large furniture, crates, cartons, and any other large items too large to be placed in containers must be collapsed and weigh not more than fifty pounds. Mattresses and box springs will have to be wrapped in heavy plastic and secured with Duct Tape.
- B. Tree and hedge trimmings must be tied and bundled, not over four feet in length, and not more than one foot in diameter, and not weigh more than forty pounds; all other yard waste must be placed in brown paper yard waste bags.
- C. Rugs, carpeting, and carpet padding must be tied and bundled, not over four feet in length, and not more than one foot in diameter, and not weigh more than thirty pounds.
- D. Refrigerator and freezer doors must be removed and must lay down flat before placing outside for collection. **DO NOT** stand upright.
- E. The following materials will **NOT** be collected: any building materials, tires, dirt, rocks, broken concrete, explosives, poison, and any other hazardous or toxic materials or substances (see below).
- F. Leaves may be piled on the tree lawn for collection from October until December for curbside collection. Please **DO NOT** put any sticks, grass, perennials, trash or any other foreign material with the leaves. At all other times, they shall be placed in brown paper yard waste bags.
- G. Any large amounts of miscellaneous trash (ex: moving out) you will need to call a private contractor to have a dumpster dropped off at your expense.
