Mitchell-

During the work session on Monday, Councilwoman Goodman mentioned that she was concerned about language in the Easement providing us the right to relocate the easement areas to wherever on the donation property we wish. I drafted the Easement and note that there is an exclusive easement area granted within which we can install, maintain and relocate our detention systems. This area is the "Detention Area" that has been contemplated all along and is depicted on Exhibit C to the Easement (see attached). Per Section 4 of the attached Easement, the language provides that we are only allowed to relocate our detention systems within the Detention Area.
