

- Adult Entertainment Research
- Overview

Chairman Arthur Goddard called the meeting to order at 7:00 P.M. Members present: Dennis Fiorelli, Martin Gallito, Mary Doria Russell and Ron Sabransky. Also present: A. Calisto Caminati, Economic Development Director.

Adult Entertainment Research – Chairman Goddard requested the commissioners to read the executive summaries at the previous meeting. The discussion continued by the Chairman as he asked the commissioners to volunteer to draft the development of the WHEREAS statements to the Resolution and to draft the development of the PREFACE to the proposed ordinances. The Chairman also expressed the importance of identifying the structure of the ordinance (cluster or dispersed). Upon completion of the previous steps, Chairman Goddard stated that a conference discussion with specific Council Members and Administration would take place. Martin Gallito raised several questions as to the validity of evaluating the adult entertainment research in the first place, as it pertains to the City of South Euclid. Several minutes of discussion ensued among the Chairman and the commissioners. It was finally agreed upon that each commissioner submit questions in writing to Alan Weinstein, who in turn, will be asked to provide a written response for each question. Everyone was in accord with this suggestion and this will be the course of action for the next meeting.

Overview - The Planning Commission plans to also target on three initiatives previously discussed within the Master Plan. They are: gun stores, tattoo parlors, adult entertainment; development of Mayfield and Cedar Roads commercial corridor districts and residential density development and or changes in setback requirements. Additional activities include five year update to the 2000 Master Plan, review of parking regulations and development of landscaping regulations.

Chairman Goddard made a motion to approve the minutes of December 18, 2008. Seconded by Ms. Russell. All ayes. Minutes approved. (5-0-0)

Chairman Goddard made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Seconded by Mr. Sabransky. All ayes. The meeting adjourned at 8:05 P.M.
