POTENTIAL SOURCES OF CARBON MONOXIDE

## Home Safety

**Check all venting systems to the outside**, including flues and chimneys for cracks, corrosion, holes, debris, or blockage.

**Check heat exchange for cracks**- be sure they are clean and free of debris.

**Check burners and ignition system.** A yellow flame in natural gas-fired furnace indicates incomplete combustion

**NEVER** run generators or warm up your car indoors.
