Barb Holtz of Ohio Prairie Nursery will speak about how you can utilize native plantings in your landscape. Coming after the well received presentation on climate change by Dr. Eric Schreiber in March, Barb's presentation will discuss how native plants can help reduce stormwater runoff, increase habitat for birds, butterflies and other critters, and over-all help reduce your carbon footprint. It promises to be a very informative presentation.

Prior to Barb's talk, Ken Messenger-Rapport, the President of Friends will speak on what Friends is doing to respond to the Trump Administration's proposal to defund the Environmental Protection Agency, and zero-out funding for the Great

Lakes Restoration Initiative a vital program for protecting and restoring Lake Erie and the entire the Great Lakes basin. Come learn about what you can do to defend the environment in northeast Ohio now and for the next four years!
