Similar to last year, we found a water quality issue during our monitoring efforts - while not as egregious as the cooking oil spill we saw in the creek last year at Acacia, NEORSD staff smelled sewage in the stream at one of the monitoring sites which is being followed up on now. Revitalizing our Ravines Workshops

Steep ravines are beautiful natural features, but some are in danger due to intensified rainfall, erosion and habitat degradation.

If you live on a steep ravine and want information on what to do to make your property more climate resilient and ecologically diverse, please attend one of our upcoming workshops.
