Paying for Critical Infrastructure Improvement Projects

- One of the key reasons South Euclid needs additional revenue is that in the next few years, we will need to fund a minimum of 20% of the cost for major repairs and the resurfacing of County Roadways including South Green Road (from border to border) and South Belvoir Blvd from Mayfield Road north to Cleveland border).
- The dedication of funds in the Capital Improvement Fund generated over the next few years from the income tax credit reduction and other sources will be utilized to help fund these necessary projects.
- Cuyahoga County & NOACA will not schedule these projects unless South Euclid commits to fund at least 20% of the project cost.

HOW MUCH WILL THESE PROJECTS COST?

The estimated cost for these projects will exceed \$8 million and the City must commit a minimum of \$2 million towards these and other upcoming infrastructure projects.
