

Q1 Generally, which of the following best describes your feelings toward the deer population in South Euclid?



Q2 Do you consider the presence of deer in our neighborhoods to be a major problem?



Q3 Overall, in your opinion, has the number of deer in your neighborhood increased during the past three years, decreased during the past three years, or stayed about the same?



Q4 In a typical week, about how many deer do you see in your neighborhood?







Q7 Increase in deer population in the future



Q8 Deer/Vehicle Accidents



Q9 Damage to landscape and garden plants



Q10 Transmission of diseases to humans or animals



Q11 Damage to park and natural area ecosystems by over-browsing on native foliage plants



Q12 Decline in deer health due to overpopulation



Q13 Individual welfare of deer











Q19 Frightening devices















Q29 Using LETHAL methods (culling deer with firearms/bows) to reduce the deer population?



Q30 Using NON-LETHAL methods (e.g. contraception and/or and sterilization) to reduce the deer population?



Q31 Assuming that each of the following NON-LETHAL methods were feasible, which of the following nonlethal methods would you prefer to be implemented?



Q32 To what extent are you concerned about the following issues related to a LETHAL control program?













Deer stands can be set up in the large wooded areas along the creek in the back yards of cooperating residents and parks. These deer stand areas can be baited. When the hunt is scheduled the bow hunters located in these stands can shoot down on the deer coming to the water to drink or to eat in the baited area. Bows are quiet and less alarming to the citizens. The deer can then be remove through the yards of the cooperating citizens or through the park. The deer meat can be offered for sale or as a donation to the food bank. The meat will need processing by approved processors.. I was wondering if the new Edwin's butchering school could find a location to learn how to process game meat as they may not be allowed to use their current site. This culling program is not a "deer hunt".. this program is about pest removal. Just as we remove nuisance ground hogs, skunks and raccoons. It would be great if communities would cooperate. The Sewer district is responsible for the creek bed I suggest their involvement because they are not elected and thus not subject to winning the vote of citizens. I love deer.. and currently our herd is fairly healthy but with continued population growth that may change. Selective killing of the "right deer" is the best way to maintain a healthy herd.
